Conservation of Threatened Species (both wild and domesticated): One award each for Individual and institutional category

Who can apply: Individuals and Institutions - organizations - Governmental as well as private working for the conservation of threatened floral and faunal species, both wild and domesticated, for the last 5 years shall be eligible to apply for this award.

Apply for what:

- Conservation, management and restoration of threatened

Threatened species does not include the species listed in the Red List (IUCN) only but also species notified under Section 38 of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002, and also includes domesticated species of plants and animals which are locally/regionally threatened species authenticated by BSI and ZSI.

Format:

- What is your contribution in rehabilitation and conservation efforts? Any innovations? **300 words**

- From which year have you started working?

- What are the conservation outcomes that have been achieved so far? **300 words**

- Please give names, address, contact number, email IDs of 3 persons who know about your work.

- Attach not more than 5 important photographs (with dates and specific locations) showing the development and status of the work.
- Applications have to be submitted in the prescribed formats which will be uploaded on websites.
