UNDP's Development Support Services aim to help improve the administrative efficiency and effectiveness of government operations and schemes at the central and state level.

UNDP's Country Programme Action Plan (2013-2017) signed with the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance enables UNDP to provide Development Support Services to the country

According to the agreement, UNDP can support administrative efficiency and develop capacities of government agencies, by providing demand-based development support services, including procurement support services, with requisite professional skills, personnel and technical resources, with applicable UNDP's standard management fee.

Development Support Services offered by UNDP include:

- **Bilateral Support Services:** to the government using governments' own funds at either central or state level
- **Multilateral Support Services:** to the government using donor funds

Capacity building and performance benchmarks are built into the agreements. While performing the development support service, UNDP simultaneously builds the capacity of the client to perform the function in the future.
